

Dear Parents,

Due to extreme illness we have seen this past year, we are instituting stricter policies.

Every year, a number of students become ill because of exposure to other ill children. We have put together a list of indicators to help you decide. If your child displays **any** of these symptoms, it is suggested that you keep your child at home.

- Fever over 100 degrees. A child should be **fever- free for 24 hours without medication before returning to school.**
- Green nasal discharge. A child nose **should be completely clear for 24 hours.**
- Persistent cough.
- Diarrhea. A child should be **completely free of diarrhea for 24 hours before returning.**
- Nausea, vomiting.
- Pink eye or eye discharge.
- A rash of unexplained origin.
- If your child has been prescribed an antibiotic, they must be on it for 24 hours before returning to school.

Please Note:

Children will be sent home at the teacher discretion if any of these symptoms are displayed.
